In this workshop you will:

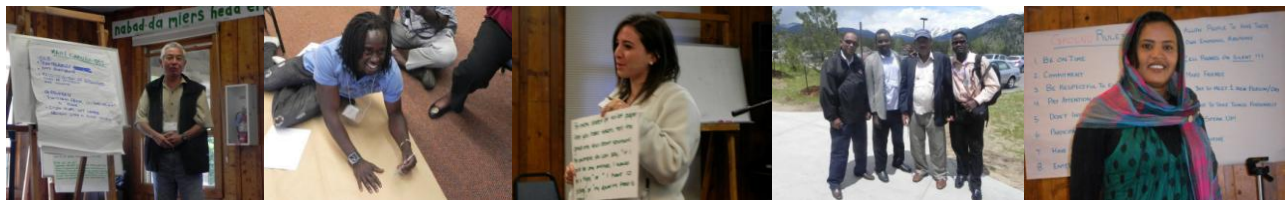
- Wrestle with your understanding of personal efficacy and responsibility
